Sweet Child O' Mine (Guns N Roses) A rockin' opener with a dazzling fusion of electronic guitar effects with brass.

Blue Rondo á La Turk (Dave Brubeck) Hang on for the ride through a flourish of mixed rhythms and cool blues solos.

Song to the Moon (Antonin Dvorak) A hauntingly beautiful opera aria featuring Allison on a soaring trumpet melody.

Je Veux Vivre (Charles Gounod) A quick and exciting "Theme and Variation" trombone feature a la Arthur Pryor. See if you can keep up with Alex and count all the notes!

Fred Jones, Part 2 (Ben Folds) Our biggest crowd favorite! A melancholy tune that features the dark colors of the flugelhorns blending with the low brass.

First Circle (Pat Metheny) In one of the most unique arrangements on the show, Tim shows off his jazz piano skills while accompanying the horns on this electrifying jazz chart!

New Dell Inn (Michael Nelson) A straight-up funk tune written by Mike Nelson, the trombone player from Prince's band and the Hornheads.

Primavera Porteño (Spring in Buenos Aires) (Astor Piazzolla) The CSBQ will transport you south of the equator with this sultry tango favorite!

Glitter in the Air (P!nk) Based on the 2009 standout Grammy Awards performance, this arrangement captures all the emotion and warmth of P!nk's brilliant vocals.

UFO Tofu (Béla Fleck) This burnin' trumpet feature by banjo virtuoso Béla Fleck showcases one of the coolest grooves you've ever heard!

Blue Spruce (Edgar Meyer) A folk tune featuring virtuoso horn playing from Tim, backed up by the low brass and piano.

Queen of the Night (Mozart) In a surprise twist on the treacherous soprano rage aria, this tune features the tuba in an acrobatic (and sometimes comical) interpretation of the Classical favorite.

The Best of Queen Medley (Freddie Mercury) Another favorite, taking you back to the big hair and rock ballads of the 70's and 80's!

Lullabye (Good Night My Angel) (Billy Joel) A beautiful tune by master songwriter Billy Joel featuring lush harmonies to send the audience away smiling with delight.
